Religion in Modern Russian History

There are two geography quizzes in this course. Below I indicate precisely what you need to know for each of them. On the web site, you will also find both historical maps that will give you the information that you need to know, and blank maps that will be useful for you as you study.

GEOGRAPHY QUIZ #1. This quiz consists of two separate maps, one that has natural features, and the other with political boundaries. On this quiz you should be able to identify and place on a blank map the following natural features: White Sea, Baltic Sea, Black Sea, Caspian Sea, Sea of Azov, Aegean Sea, Mediterranean Sea, Danube River, Dnieper River, Don River, Volga River, Ural Mountains, Carpathian Mountains, Caucasus Mountains, and Crimea. On a blank map of Europe in 1721 (borders will be provided), you should be able to locate the following states: Russian Empire, Poland, Sweden, Denmark, Ottoman Empire, Austria (=Austria + Kingdom of Hungary), France, Spain, Great Britain, Prussia.

GEOGRAPHY QUIZ #2. On a blank map, you should be able to locate the following republics of the USSR, as they appeared in 1936: Russian Soviet Federated Socialist Republic, Ukrainian SSR, Belarusian SSR, Georgian SSR, Armenian SSR, Azerbaijan SSR, Kazakh SSR, Uzbek SSR, Turkmen SSR, Kirgiz SSR, and Tadjik SSR. You should also be able to identify the USSR's neighbors: Finland, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Turkey, Iran, Afghanistan, China, Mongolia, and Korea.
