Notable Events

1864	Judicial reform, including introduction of trial by jury
1872	Creation of special courts for “political” trials
1877-78	Trials of the 50 and the 193 (trials of “going to people” activists)
1878	Vera Zasulich’s assassination attempt of St. Petersburg governor Trepov Trial of Vera Zasulich resulting in her acquittal Political trials involving “armed” actions transferred to military tribunals
1879	Formation of People’s Will
